“Terms and Conditions of the Auction”

The EMIRATES ARABIAN HORSE SOCIETY is the organizing authority of the sale.

The Official venue will be at Sharjah Equestrian and Racing Club.

A. Conditions & Costs

All horses that will be offered for genuine sale are subject to the following:

- 1 – Horses must be in registration at EAHS.
- 2 – Horse with race or show Pedigree.
- 3 – Horse will only be accepted for inclusion in the catalogue following receipt of a properly completed and signed Entry Form.
- 4 – A non-refundable fee of AED 1500 will be charged against the registered owner of each horse entered for the auction.
- 5 – 4% of purchase price will be deducted from each sold horse as commission.
- 6 – Horses will only be accepted into the sales’ ring after having been positively identified.
- 7 – If the buyer not collected the horse immediately after the Auction, the Seller is liable to keep their sold horses up to 14 days to finalize the export and sale procedures.
- 8 – Entry of Horse is subject to the approval of Auction Committee.
- 9 – Original Horse Passport with valid Vaccination must be submitted to the Auction Office on arrival.
- 10 – A signed Change of Ownership Application must be submitted at the Auction Office.
- 11 –Covering Certificate with signature must be attached with the Entry Form in case of Mare in foal.

B. Purchases

Each intended buyer:

- 1 – Must be over 21 years old
- 2 – Must complete and sign a registration form supplied by the EAHS giving full name address and contact numbers.
- 3 – Must deposit the sum of AED 10,000

Such deposit will enable the intended purchaser to secure a “bidding number”. Each “bidding number” is for sole, personal use and the intended purchase in whose name the “bidding number” is registered, will be deemed to be personally responsible for all purchases, keep fees and associated charges accorded against such “bidding number”.

The deposit will be refunded in full should no purchases be made or adjusted against any purchase price or keep charges. A refund of the deposit will be arranged within 7 days of the Sale.

- 4 – Bids will only be accepted from registered bidders who are in possession of a “bidding number”;

C – Charges & Settlements

1 – The sale is conducted on a “buyers beware” principle with no guarantees on any purchase. Each lot becomes the property of the highest bidder at the fall of the auctioneer’s hammer; such purchaser shall assume the responsibility for all cost and expenses related to the care, custody and control of such horse. Any purchaser failing to comply with this condition will forfeit their deposit and will face legal follow up.

2 – At the completion of each sale, the purchaser shall forthwith complete and sign the “Acknowledgement of Purchase” form.

3 – Full payment of the purchase price and all keep charges shall be made to EAHS within 5 days of the Sale. For horses that do not require export testing, the EAHS will charge AED 100 per day for horses stabled at Auction Stables. This charge will be for keep charges plus any other associated costs for each horse not collected on the day following its sale. For horses that require testing for export, the keep charge of AED 100 per day will apply from the 10th day after the sale irrespective of its analytical or vaccination status. The EAHS shall retain each horse’s passport until full payment is received. If a purchaser fails to make full payment by this time, such horse will revert to the property of the original owner and the intended purchaser’s deposit will be forfeited. Further legal actions will be taken against such bidders.

4 – All sold horses shall be removed from Auction Stables immediately after the sale.

5 – Purchase must complete EAHS change of ownership request within 5 days after the auction.

D – Responsibilities

1 – Purchasers are responsible for the removal, transportation and where appropriate, exportation (and all associated costs) of his horses according to the Rules of EAHS.

2 – It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure that all horses offered for sale have been vaccinated. Any horse that is deemed upon inspection on sale day not to have its vaccination up to date will not be permitted to enter the sale ring area.

3 – In the case of any dispute related to any matter concerning this sale the decision of the Auction Committee shall be final and binding on all the parties. Data provided in the catalogue is generally accurate but occasionally errors occur as a result of incorrect data submission, processing errors and other causes. EMIRATES ARABIAN HORSE SOCIETY hereby disclaims all liability for such errors.
